I will....

- Be encouraging, supportive and affirmative in regard to my child's play on the field. I will only cheer for my Child and the team- I will NOT yell ANY instructions!
- Respect officials and accept their decisions
- Support the coach, manager and the team
- Volunteer my services and talents to the Club when possible
- Familiarize myself with the Laws of the Game
- Comply with the rules, policies, and procedures of the team and the club as they apply to me.
- Discuss my child
 1. Only with my coach
 2. Not with the manager or any other person
 3. Only at a time mutually agreed up on by the coach
 4. Never prior to, during or directly after a game

Further I will never...

- Engage in dissent directed to an official
- Engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach manager, player or parent
- Interfere at any time with the duties and responsibilities of the coach or manager
- Act in any way that is detrimental to the team or MSA
- Coach from the sidelines
